Competition Rules

- Entry is \$5.50 per person. This entry fee applies to teams entering the "Biloela's Best" and the "Young Gun's" Competitions.
- Each team may have a maximum of four (4) members. These members will be nominated at the start of the competition and are not interchangeable.
- All competitors are to be on site by 6.00am for briefing. No fires are to be lit until 6.10am.
- Firewood will be supplied for cooking purposes. It is acceptable to bring your own.
- All competitors are to provide their own ingredients, camp ovens, shovels and any other tools required.
- Competitors who are using any ingredient which is of a wild source (kangaroo, rabbit, fish or other bush tucker) must ensure it is fit for human consumption as per the Australian Food Safety Rules and Regulations.
- No commercially pre-packed ingredients are allowed to be used in the cooking competition. Including but not limited to: Gravox/gravy powder, tinned fruit, pastry sheets, cake mixes, etc. Ingredients that may be used include: plain flour, self-raising flour, baking powder, rice, curry powder, raisins/sultanas, salt, pepper, dry herbs and spices.
- The use of trivets, cake tins and baking paper is allowed except for the plain damper which is to be cooked directly into the camp oven in a more traditional way.
- Competitors must have everything they require for the days cooking within their cooking site including fridges (battery run) and eskies. No food, ingredients, cooking utensils are to be acquired from other sources (e.g. handed over the fence).
- Competitors are not to sell or make profit from any food pre-made or cooked on site during the competition.
- All entries are to be cooked at your nominated site.
- Health regulations and cleanliness must be abided by at all times.
- Organisers will have the final say in all matters of safety. Competitors are to ensure the safety of their team members within their cooking site at all times.
- Enclosed footwear must be worn in the cooking area. Thongs and sandals are not acceptable at any time whilst in the cooking area. Failure to adhere to this rule may mean loss of points or disqualification.
- Judging will be at the discretion of the judge/s whose decision will be final. Judging will be on a points system and will include presentation, taste and cleanliness.
- The People's Choice Awards will also be awarded to teams. These awards will include: an award for the best cooking area presentation, an award for the best dressed team, an award for the team who is the crowd favourite. These awards will be voted for by the public.
- All competitors enters at their own risk.
